TLC Top Ten Talking Tips

to help your child's communication

Say your child's name first as this will gain their attention.

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Repeat back what your child says to model language and let them know you are listening. Get down to your child's level so they can see your face when you speak.

> Follow your child's lead so they know you are interested in what they are doing.

Comment on what your child is doing as this will help them learn new words. know you ed in what doing. Make m and ask

Make more comments and ask less questions as this will help build their vocabulary.

Use gestures when you are talking as this will

give your child extra clues to help them understand what you are saying.

Pause to give your child time to think, give your child at least 10 seconds to process information.

Speak in short sentences to help them understand
